




ow we know that whatever the Mosaic law says, it says to those who are under the law, that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God. Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in his sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin.

fut now the righteougness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed Mby the law and the prophets, even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. for there is no difference; for all have SINNED AND FALL SHORT OF THE GLORY OF GOD, being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, Whom God set forth as a propitiation by his blood, through faith, to demonstrate 1715 righteousness, because 1N forbearance God had passed over the sins That were previously committed, to demonstrate at the present time his righteousness, that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus. Therefore we conclude that a man 15 JUSTIFIED BY FAITH APART FROM THE DEEDS of the law.

any longer in it? Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into this death? For if we have been united together in the likeness of his death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of his resurrection, knowing this, that our old man was crucified with him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin.

or the death that he died, he died to sing once for all; but the life that he lives, he lives to God. Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord. Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God. For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

or the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the

Flesh, God didby sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: he condemned sin in the flesh, that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Sprit.

or those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, BUT those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. For to be CARNALLY MINDED 15 DEATH, BUT TO BE spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity against GOD; FOR IT 15 NOT SUBJECT TO THE LAW OF God, nor indeed can be. So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not his. And if Christ is in you, the body 15 dead because of sin, but the Spirit 15 life because of righteousness.

or since by Man [Adam] came death, by Man [Jesus Christ] also came the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. But each one wn order: Christ the first-fruits.

IN his own order: Christ the first-fruits, Afterward those who are Christ's at his coming. Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the father, when he puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. For he must reign till he has put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that will be destroyed is death.

ow when all things are made subject to him, then the Son himself will also be subject to him who put all things under him, that God may be all in all. And so it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being." The last Adam became a living spirit.

owever, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual. The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the lord from heaven.







S WAS THE MAN OF DUST, SO ALSO ARE THOSE WHO ARE MADE OF DUST; AND AS 15 THE HEAVENLY MAN, SO ALSO ARE THOSE WHO ARE HEAVENLY. AND AS WE HAVE BORNE THE IMAGE OF THE MAN OF DUST, WE SHALL ALSO BEAR THE IMAGE OF THE HEAVENLY MAN.

mow this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; Whor does corruption inherit incorruption. Behold, 1 Tell you A mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For This corruptible must put on incorruption, AND THIS MORTAL MUST PUT ON IMMORTALITY. So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "Death is SWALLOWED UP IN VICTORY." "O DEATH, where 15 your sting? O hades, where 15 your VICTORY?" The STING OF DEATH 15 SIN, AND the strength of sin 15 the law. nd the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham beforehand, saying, "In you all the nations shall be blessed." So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham.

or as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them." But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God is evident, for "the just shall live by faith." Yet the law is not of faith, but "the man who does them shall live by them."

the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed 15 everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. 15 the law then against the promises of Goo? Certainly not!









or if there had been a law given which could have given life, truly righteousness would have been by the law. But the Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe. But before faith came, we were kept under guard by the law, kept for the faith which would afterward be revealed.

herefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by Faith. But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor. For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

here is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in christ Jesus. And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and here according to the promise.

ut when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!"

herefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an here of God through Christ. Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.
