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FREFACE

And God spoke all these words, saying: "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold *him* guiltless who takes his name in vain."

Then Moses said to God, "Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they say to me, 'What is his name?' what shall I say to them?" And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And he said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'" Scripture is clear and explicit, Adam was the first man created, the progenitor of the human race – who when put to the test by his Creator was found wanting! He proved to be rebellious and disobedient to God, handed over his allegiance and delegated authority to the 'flesh' and the 'devil', and contaminated his offspring (the human race) with his 'sin'. His nature is become our (human) nature, therefore we are born spiritually dead to and separated from our Creator.

But no surprise to God! Scripture tells us that one was foreordained before the foundation of the world to come into the world to rescue us and provide the way to restore Mankind to communion and fellowship with God.

This eternal anointed one could only be the second person of the Holy Trinity, God the Son, the Beloved of God the Father – known to us through his incarnation as Jesus Christ. And to this one the Old and New Testaments give many other profound and meaningful names! This volume aims simply to reference and consider some of the numerous titles applied to the one whom God the Father has set above all and over all – the one to whom every knee shall bow.

'JESUS':

Greek form of the Hebrew name Joshua or Yeshua meaning Saviour or Yahweh (Jehovah) saves. Hence the angel telling Joseph to call Mary's child JESUS, for his incarnation provided the way for humanity to be redeemed and restored to fellowship with God – that is to be saved from bondage to sin and death and no longer be separated from God. Scripture makes it clear that the 'free gift' offered to all who believe in Jesus, and acknowledge him as Lord, cost God that which was most precious to him – the second person of the Trinity. Jesus took upon himself the punishment for all our sins. He died a brutal 'sinners' death in our place so that we might be justified and declared righteous before God.

'CHRIST':

The Greek form of the Hebrew translated as Messiah – the one 'anointed' by God to be the eternal greater son of David. The King, High Priest and Prophet whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. The one to whom every knee will bow and every tongue confess him to be Lord. Matthew and Luke tell us that Jesus (the man) was in direct bloodline from king David through both Joseph and Mary.

'THE WORD':

This 'name' had profound meaning for both Hebrew and Greek/Gentile readers.

The Old Testament refers to 'the word of God' being spoken many times. Indeed, when 'God said', time, space, matter, light and life were all created out of nothing [Genesis 1 & 2]! "For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, so shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth; it shall not return to me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper *in the thing* for which I sent it.", so says God of his Word in Isaiah chapter 55.

And for Greek/Gentile readers, the 'Logos' was, in philosophical terms, God's plan for all things and the creative power to accomplish his will. Jesus said, "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given *them* to me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of my Father's hand. I and my Father are one."





'REDEEMER'

The one who paid the necessary price or ransom to deliver an enslaved race from bondage. So the Son of God entered the world (that he had created) as one of us, a human being – yet without sin because he was not born of the seed of Adam. Nevertheless, as a man he died a sinner's death taking our place and as our substitute. His death paid the ransom acceptable to God to release us from 'bondage' and make 'new creations'.

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace which he made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, having made known to us the mystery of his will, that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times he might gather together in one all things in Christ. Not with the blood of goats and calves [the sacrificial system], but with his own blood he entered the Most Holy Place [the inner sanctum of the Temple] once for all, having obtained eternal redemption [for all who put their trust in Jesus Christ and accept his sacrifice].

'RIGHTEOUS JUDGE'

The eternal holy one who has ultimate authority and power to determine both destiny and final destination of every human being – about whom he knows everything, including the intentions and motivations of every heart!

To the church in Corinth the Apostle Paul wrote, 'For we must all appear before the judgement seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things *done* in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.' If this is the situation for believers, those who reject Christ and make his blood of no account will have no hope!

Jesus talking to the religious leaders said, "For the Father judges no one, but has committed all judgement to the Son, that all should honour the Son just as they honour the Father. He who does not honour the Son does not honour the Father who sent him. Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears my word and believes in him who sent me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgement, but has passed from death into life. As I hear, I judge; and my judgement is righteous, because I do not seek my own will but the will of the Father who sent me.

his is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who is preferred before me, for he was before me.' I did not know him; but that he should be revealed to Israel, therefore I came baptizing with water."

'LAMB OF GOD'

Human sin is abhorrent to God. To the first human (Adam) he said, 'creation is yours to manage and enjoy, but don't touch the one thing I tell you, because if you do you will die!' Not only did we – humanity with Adam's nature – disobey God, we also handed our allegiance over to a usurper in whose lap the whole world now lies.

God said – and he cannot lie – that death (spiritual and physical) will be the consequence of sin. The sacrificial system substituted the death of an innocent animal in place of human sin. In its ultimate form, for God to forgive the sins of humanity and restore the fellowship he desires required the ultimate sacrifice to get even one human being into God's kingdom. The only sacrifice acceptable to God the Father was that of his sinless, spotless Son - who became one of us, lived our human life yet without any sin of his own, and died in our place to propitiate God's wrath against sin so that a Way was made to restore peace. In the Father's 'eyes', the blood shed for us by the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ his Son, justifies all who believe in him as Lord and Saviour. Old and New Testament Scriptures reveal the Lamb.

Isaiah 53: All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all. He was oppressed and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth; he was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent, so he opened not his mouth. He was taken from prison and from judgement, and who will declare his generation? For he was cut off from the land of the living; for the transgressions of my people he was stricken. And they made his grave with the wicked—but with the rich at his death, because he had done no violence, nor was any deceit in his mouth. Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he has put him to grief. When you make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. He shall see the labour of his soul, and be satisfied. By his knowledge my righteous Servant shall justify many, for he shall bear their iniquities.

Hebrews 9: But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with his own blood he entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission. For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us; not that he should offer himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another—he then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, he has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself. And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgement, so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for him he will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

I Peter 1: And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one's work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay *here* in fear; knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, *like* silver or gold, from your aimless conduct *received* by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot. hy do the nations rage, and the people plot a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD and against his Anointed, saying, "Let us break their bonds in pieces and cast away their cords from us."

'SHEPHERD'

"Son of man [Ezekiel], prophesy against the shepherds of Israel, prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD to the shepherds: "Woe to the shepherds of Israel who feed themselves! Should not the shepherds feed the flocks? The weak you have not strengthened, nor have you healed those who were sick, nor bound up the broken, nor brought back what was driven away, nor sought what was lost; but with force and cruelty you have ruled them. So they were scattered because *there was* no shepherd; and they became food for all the beasts of the field when they were scattered. My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and on every high hill; yes, my flock was scattered over the whole face of the earth, and no one was seeking or searching *for them.*"

nd so it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being." The last Adam [Christ] became a life-giving spirit. Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption.

Behold, I tell you a mystery: we shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.

'THESECOND MAN'

But someone will say, "How are the dead raised up? And with what body do they come?" Foolish one, what you sow is not made alive unless it dies. And what you sow, you do not sow that body that shall be, but mere grain—perhaps wheat or some other *grain*. But God gives it a body as he pleases, and to each seed its own body.

So also *is* the resurrection of the dead. *The body* is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption. It is sown in dishonour, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power. It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

And the SCONE that struck the image became a great mountain and filled the whole earth." for through him [Christ] we both [Jews & Gentiles] have access by one Spirit to the Father. Now, therefore, you are no longer strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the CHIEF CORNERSCONE, in whom the whole building, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit,

KEVELATION CHAPTER 5

'LION OF JUDAH

Thus God, determining to show more abundantly to the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed *it* by an oath, that by two immutable things, in which it *is* impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before *us.* This *hope* we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters the *Presence* behind the veil, where the forerunner has entered for us, *even* Jesus, having become High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.

For this Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings and blessed him, to whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all, first being translated "king of righteousness," and then also king of Salem, meaning "king of peace," without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but made like the Son of God, remains a priest continually. Now consider how great this man was, to whom even the patriarch Abraham gave a tenth of the spoils.

And indeed those who are of the sons of Levi, who receive the priesthood, have a commandment to receive tithes from the people according to the law, that is, from their brethren, though they have come from the loins of Abraham; but he whose genealogy is not derived from them received tithes from Abraham and blessed him who had the promises. Now beyond all contradiction the lesser is blessed by the better. For it is evident that our Lord [Jesus Christ] arose from Judah, of which tribe Moses spoke nothing concerning priesthood. And it is yet far more evident if, in the likeness of Melchizedek, there arises another priest who has come, not according to the law of a fleshly commandment, but according to the power of an endless life. For he [God] testifies: "You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek."

And Jacob called his sons and said, "Gather together, that I may tell you what shall befall you in the last days: Judah *is* a lion's whelp; from the prey, my son, you have gone up. He bows down, he lies down as a lion; and as a lion, who shall rouse him? The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh [Messiah] comes; and to him shall be the obedience of the people." To the LORD God said to the serpent [Satan]:

"Because you have done this, you *are* cursed more than all cattle, and more than every beast of the field; on your belly you shall go, and you shall eat dust all the days of your life. And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her Seed; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."

Poreover the LORD spoke again to Ahaz,

saying, "Ask a sign for yourself from the LORD your God; ask it either in the depth or in the height above." But Ahaz said, "I will not ask, nor will I test the LORD!"
"Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call his name Immanuel."

ow in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David.

Che virgin's name was Mary.

And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favoured *one*, the Lord *is* with you; blessed *are* you among women!" 
