






No king is saved by the multitude of an army; a mighty man is not delivered by great strength. A horse is a vain hope for safety; neither shall it deliver any by its great strength.

And he shall live; and the gold of Sheba will be given to him; Prayer also will be made for him continually, and daily he shall be praised.


There will be an abundance of grain in the earth, on the top of the mountains; its fruit shall wave like Lebanon; and *those* of the city shall flourish like grass of the earth.

od stands in the congregation of the mighty; he judges among the gods. How long will you judge unjustly, and show partiality to the wicked? Selah


Defend the poor and fatherless; do justice to the afflicted and needy. Deliver the poor and needy; free *them* from the hand of the wicked.


They do not know, nor do they understand; they walk about in darkness; all the foundations of the earth are unstable.


I said, "You are gods, and all of you are children of the Most High. But you shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes."

Arise, O God, judge the earth; for you shall inherit all nations.













You are my God, and I will praise you; you are my God, I will exalt you. Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for he is good! For his mercy endures forever.








hen the multitudes who went before and those who followed cried out, saying:
"Hosanna to the Son of David! 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the LORD!' [The Messiah, the Christ] Hosanna in the highest!"





And Jesus said to them, "Yes. Have you never read, 'Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants you have perfected praise'?"










For the LORD knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the ungodly shall perish.









Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the LORD delivers him out of them all.




They will call on my name, and I will answer them. I will say, 'This is my people'; and each one will say, 'The LORD is my God.'"







For the promise that he would be the heir of the world was not to Abraham or to his seed through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.


"Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame."


Men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, since that plague was exceedingly great.




hen a voice came from the throne, saying,

those who fear him, both small and great!"


