matchem 6: 7 - 13

this volume is one of a group of four which together are intended to illustrate great abiding truths in god's word in the holy bible, namely:

thy word is truth

the holy bible is quite clear and unequivocal that, beginning with the first man and woman (adam and eve) who rebelled against their creator and wilfully disobeyed his command to them, all humanity has sinned against the holy god of eternity — and the wages of sin is death (eternal separation from the presence of god).

however, even though we are all convicted of sin by the truth in god's holy law of perfect righteousness, yet his grace offers all sinners – that is the whole human race – salvation without condemnation through the person of the son of god, jesus christ. Jesus (heb. 'salvation' or 'jehovah is salvation') said himself that he came out of eternity and into the world to 'call sinners to repentance', and to reconcile back into god's presence all who put their trust in the son's finished work of redemption.

But god's patience is not endless toward a perverse, corrupt and desperately wicked humanity that continues to love its sin. therefore, the time of god's judgment will come upon a christ rejecting world – god promises it!

sounding of the seventh angel

elohim, goð the creator, gave to the first man (aðam) and the first woman (eve) authority, rule and dominion over his creation and the world made for them. But they, wilfully disregarding god's warning to them, carelessly handed over this authority to the serpent of old – the devil – so that he became the 'ruler of this age'. [for example see luke 4, verses 5 & 6]. however, god's plan is revelaed to us that these present 'times of the gentiles will be fulfilled' according to the word spoken by the lord jesus christ, and then the son of man will be seen coming again to the world – but this time on clouds of glory and with all power.

so the book of revelation takes us to the time set by god the father for christ to take back creation for him from the usurper, and to finally bring all things and all humanity into judgment. the prophet malachi poses the inspired question, 'who shall stand when he appears?' – to which the answer is 'only those who are in christ jesus'!

hallowed be thy name

throughout the holy bible's scriptures there are men and women recorded who have recognized, experienced and rejoiced in the knowledge of god's great power, longsuffering mercy, abundant providences, plan of redemption and exalted glory. Their response has been to express themselves in 'doxologies' (hymns and psalms of praise to god), praises for the god of glory, the lord of heaven and earth, abound and culminate in the rejoicing of all the saints of all the ages and all the holy angels as christ redeems the creation and restores it to the father – then dismisses the old corrupted order so as to create the new!

call his name emman'uel (god-with-us)

throughout its 66 books the holy bible is really the story of one person — his recemptive work, his ultimate judgment of humanity and his very nature that reveal the one true god to the world, he is the second person of the godhead who stepped down from eternity and into the world as jesus of nazareth to save his people from their bondage to sin and death, he came to bring us back into relationship and fellowship with the creator himself. God the father has chosen to bestow on his only beloved many names, titles and descriptions which abound through the pages of scripture, which when taken together form the words which show myriad facets of jesus christ the lord.



Then Moses and the chiloren of israel sans this sons to the lord, and spoke sayins:

The LORO is my strength and song, and he has become my salvation; he is my God, and he has become my salvation; he is my God, and he will praise him; my father's God, and he will exalt him. The LORO is a man of war; the LORO is his name. Pharaoh's chariots and his army he has cast into the sea; his chosen captains also are drowned in the Red Sea. The depths have covered them; they sank to the bottom like a stone.

OUR RISHE hand, O LORD, has become slorious in power; Your Rishe hand, O LORD, has dashed the enemy in pieces. And in the sreatness of Your excellence You have overthrown those who rose against You; You sent porch Your wrath; it consumed them like stubble. And with the blast of Your nostrils the waters were sathered to sether; the floods stood uprishe like a heap; the depths consealed in the heart of the sea.

he enemy said, "I will pursue, I will overcake, I will divide the spoil; my desire shall be satisfied on them. I will draw my sword, my hand shall destroy them." You blew with Your wind, the sea covered them; they sank like lead in the mighty waters.

holiness, rearrul in praises, roing wonders? You screeched our Your right hand; the earth swallowed them. You in Your mercy have led porth the people whom You have redeemed; You have suided them in Your scrensth to Your holy habitation.

he people will hear and be arraid; sorrow will take hold of the inhabitants of Philis'tia. Chen the chiefs of e'oom will be dismayed; the mighty men of Mo'ab, trembling will take hold of them; all the inhabitants of Ca'naan will melt away. Fear and dread will fall on them; by the greatness of Your arm they will be as still as a stone, till Your people pass over, O lord, till the people pass over whom You have purchased.



The LORO will judge the ends of the earth. he will sive strength to his king, and exalt the horn of his anoinced."

i samuel 2: 1 - 10



Then David spoke to the lord the words of this song, on the day when the lord had belivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul. And he said:

he lord is my rock and my forcress and my deliverer; the God of my scrength, in whom I will trust; my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold and my refuse; my Saviour, You save me from violence. From the brightness before him coals of fire were kindled.

he loro chundered from heaven, and the most high uccered his voice. He sent out arrows and scattered them; lightning bolts, and he vanquished them. Then the channels of the sea were seen, the foundations of the world were uncovered, at the rebuke of the loro, at the blast of the breath of his nostrils.

e sent from above, he took me, he onew me out or many waters. he belivered me from my scronz enemy, from chose who haceo me; ror they were too strong for me. They confronceo me in the day of my calamity, but the LORO was my support. He also brought me out into a broad place; he delivered me because he velighted in me. The LORO Rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness or my hands he has recompensed me. For I have kept the ways or the LORO, and have not wickerly reparted from my Goo. For all his juosments were before me; and as for his scacuces, 1 010 not bepare from them. 1 was also blameless before him, and I kept myself from my iniquicy. Therefore the LORO has recompensed me according to my righteousness, according to my cleanness in his eyes.

ICh che merciful You will show Yourself merciful; with a blameless man You will show Yourself blameless; with the pure You will show Yourself pure; and with the pevious You will show Yourself shrewo. You will save the humble people; but Your eyes are on the haughty, that You may bring them bown.

OR You are my lamp, O loro; the loro shall enlighten my darkness. For by You I can run against a troop; by my God I can leap over a wall. As por God, his way is perfect; the word of the loro is proven; he is a shield to all who trust in him.

OR who is Goo, except the LORO? And who is a rock, except our Goo? God is my strength and power, and he makes my way perfect. He makes my feet like the reet of deer, and sets me on my high places. He teaches my hands to make war, so that my arms can bend a bow of bronze. You have also given me the shield of Your salvation; Your gentleness has made me great. You enlarged my path under me; so my feet did not slip.





he is the tower of salvation to his king, and shows mercy to his anointed, to David and his descendants porevermore."


ii samuel 22: 1 - 51

In them he has set a cabernacle for the sun, which is like a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoices like a strong man to run its race. 


isaiah 61: 1 - 3



Duc now I come to You, and these things 1 speak in the world, that they may have My joy rulrilleo in chemselves. I have siven chem Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the worlo, just as 1 am not of the worlo. I do not pray that You should take them out of the worlo, but that You should keep them rrom the evil one. They are not or the worlo, just as 1 am not of the worlo.





Cherefore, since we are the offspring of Goo, we ought not to think that the Divine Nature is like solo or silver or scone, something shaped by arc and man's bevising. Cruly these times or isnorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent, because he has appointed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom he has ordained. he has given assurance of this to all by RAISING him From the Dead."

Orechren, 1 oo not count myself to have apprehenoeo; buc one thing 1 vo, rorsecting those chings which are behind and reaching porward to those things which are ahead, I press toward the soal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.




